The Curbside Recycling Program

Recycling reduces the volume of waste sent to landfill and plays an important part in preserving the quality of the environment. You can do your part by participating in West Valley Disposal's Recycling Program. Blue recycle totes should be filled with recyclable materials generated in the home and should be free of trash. When trash is placed in the blue recycle tote, it can contaminate the recyclables which effects how much material is recovered. A blue recycling tote with unacceptable materials cannot be collected on collection day. Please see below for a detailed list of what materials are included in the Curbside Recycling Program. Have an item that you are unsure is recyclable? Call the office or email support@westvalleydisposal.com to find out! To participate in the Recycling Program, fill your blue tote with recyclables and put the tote at the curb on collection day. It's that simple! The recyclable contents will be sorted and processed at Tracy Material Recovery, then sold to end users where they will be made into recycled content products.

Recycle

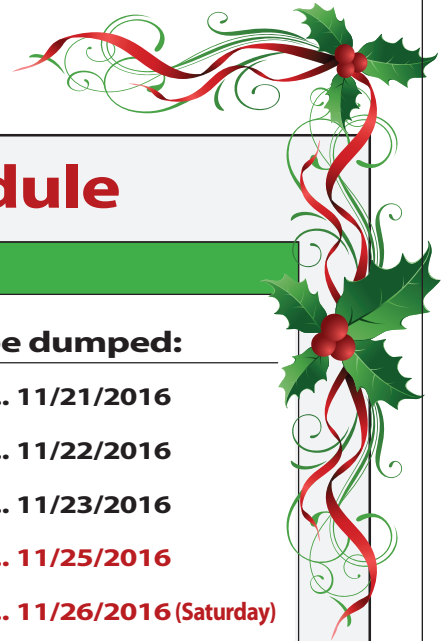
